Do all zinc coatings provide similar corrosion protection?

This is a common question and the answer can be very confusing because of miscommunication in the market place. Some suppliers call any type of zinc coating "galvanized," which is incorrect and can be very misleading. Not all zinc coatings are created equal in terms of corrosion protection – let's compare the differences between **batch** and **continuous** galvanized coatings, **zinc rich paint**, **mechanical plating**, and **metallizing**.
